CONDITIONS OF ENTRY 14th ANNUAL TROPICAL BREEDS BULL SALE - ROMA - 22nd OCTOBER 2010

Closing date for nominations: 28th July 2010

1. To be **eligible** to nominate and **sell** at Society Sponsored Sales, a vendor must be a fully financial Stud (Full) or Junior Member of the Droughtmaster Breeders' Society with no overdue debts (outside the normal trading terms) owed to the Society.
2. **Nomination Fees**
Registered & Herd Bulls.....\$100.00 (Plus GST)
3. To be a valid entry for a Society Sponsored Sale the following must be completed, signed and received **by mail** with the relevant nomination fees at the Society Office no later than the close of business on the closing date for nominations:
 - a) Signed copy of these Entry Conditions
 - b) Signed Breeder Declaration
 - c) Signed Droughtmaster Society Nomination Form
 - d) Original Registration Certificates duly endorsed
 - e) Herd bull Nomination Form (if required)
 - f) All nomination & Royalty Fees (if applicable)

FAXED, EMAILED OR LATE NOMINATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Nominations to be received by mail, post marked no later than 28th July.

4. The applicant will complete such other forms as the Society may require.
5. **REGISTERED BULLS:**
 - (a) A Registered Bull must conform to the Standard of Excellence (Clause 23 of the Constitution).
 - (b) The ORIGINAL registration certificate (with reverse side signed) with the selling agent and selling preference (if any) written on the top of the front of the certificate in PENCIL, to be forwarded to the Society office with the nomination form. This will be returned to the Vendor after the sale, should the animal not be sold.
 - (c) All registered animals will be automatically transferred to the purchaser at no additional cost to the vendor.

- (d) All registrations for sale bulls must be received at the society office before close of business 23rd June (mailed registrations will be accepted if postmarked no later than 23rd June, 2010).
- (e) All registration certificates must accompany the nomination forms.
- (f) Vendor retention of a share or semen rights in a bull, for use in own herd must be declared in nominations & the sale catalogue otherwise the resultant progeny will be ineligible for registration with the Society.

6. COMMERCIAL (HERD) BULLS:

- (a) Herd bull nominations **MUST** be made on Droughtmaster Society nomination forms. No other forms will be accepted.
- (b) Where more than one agent is involved, keep herd bulls nominated with each agent on separate Herd Bull nomination forms. (Additional forms available from Society Office).
- (c) A Herd Bull must conform to the Standard of Excellence (Clause 23 of the Constitution); with **both** parents being Droughtmasters and herd bulls must have at least one registered Droughtmaster parent with its registered Ident. Number quoted and exhibit individual firebrand identification as quoted on the nomination form.

7. Sale Nominations are accepted subject to restrictions, if required, being implemented by the Sale Committee in consultation with the Board.

- (a) Number nominations called for and accepted at the discretion of the committee. **Number nominations to be received at the Society Office before close of business 12th May (number nominations will be accepted if postmarked no later the 12th May).** No fee required with number nominations, however requested nominations cannot exceed an individual stud average nominations over the last 3 years, by more than 2 head.
- (b) Sale nominations will not be accepted without number nominations being previously accepted by the committee.
- (c) Maximum of 220 bulls will be accepted for nomination for the 2010 sale. Reductions will be implemented should excess bulls be nominated above the target number.
- (d) Vendors who have sold at any of the last 3 sales will have their nominated numbers dropped by the percentage by which the total nominations exceed the sale target of 220 head.
- (e) A “new vendor” will be any vendor who has not nominated bulls at any of the 3 previous sales.
- (f) New vendors may nominate a maximum of two bulls.

8. Nomination Fees for all cattle must accompany nomination forms. Nomination fees are non refundable on the close of nominations.

9. To qualify for entry to the sale, herds must be assessed – confirmed free, tested negative or have a monitored negative status for Brucellosis & Tuberculosis.
10. Only polled, scurred or **dehorned** stock may be sold at Society Sponsored Sales.
11. Vendors nominating animal's bred from Multiple Sires must submit (at the time of nomination) the names of all the multiple sires for inclusion in the sale catalogue.
12. All stock must have been vaccinated with TRIVALENT (3 germ) TICK FEVER VACCINE (AT LEAST 60 DAYS PRIOR TO SALE DATE) and have a current "5 in 1" or "7 in 1" immunisation.
13. **Only** Ultrasound Scanning results carried out by accredited (PBBA) scanners (Performance Beef Breeds Association) can be published and/or advertised. (List of registered scanners is available from the Society).
14. All bulls offered for sale must undergo and pass the **ACV Bull Soundness Evaluation for Scrotum, Physical & Semen** by a qualified veterinarian within 42 days of the sale. A copy of the ACV Summary Certificate must be forwarded to the office no later than 7 days prior to the sale.

The **Original** ACV Bull Soundness Evaluation Summary Certificate must be brought to the sale and be available for inspection if requested by a Sale Committee Representative(s). The ACV Certificate can be displayed on the sale pens of bulls if so desired.

The **Morphology & Serving Capacity** sections of the ACV Soundness Evaluation are optional, but if evaluated then the bull **must pass** the criteria set down by the ACV to be eligible for the sale. **If Morphology is evaluated the only acceptable results are a "✓", "P" or "NT"**. Bulls with "NA" recorded on Morphology are **not** eligible for sale.

Minimum Scrotal Measurements

12-15 months	– Minimum 30cm
18 months	– Minimum 32 cm
24 months and over	– Minimum 34cm

Bulls with Scrotal Sizes less than above measurements at the specified age are not eligible to be sold.

15. Prior to penning at the saleyards all stock must have been paint branded with their designated lot number and carry the supplied Droughtmaster lot number eartag in the near side ear.
16. If an animal has had an injury, illness or defect or has undergone treatment (excepting tick treatments) within 14 days of sale, a Health Treatment Declaration must accompany that animal. The original should be handed to the Sale Committee Representative, a copy attached to the pen, and the animal's condition be explained at the time of selling from the auctioneer's box.
17. Any offers by vendors of free semen or vendor finance must be noted in the Catalogue. Vendor Retention of share or semen rights in a bull for use in own herd must be declared in nominations & the sale catalogue otherwise the resultant progeny will be ineligible for registration with the Society.
18. Withdrawal of any lot or lots must be notified to the Society office or the Sale Committee Representative by 2 pm the day prior to the sale. A tear out

Form is available in the catalogue for this purpose.

19. All stock must enter the saleyards complex no later than 4pm on the day preceding the sale, and on sale day be in their allocated pens available for buyer inspection at least 2hrs prior to the nominated time for commencement of selling, and remain in their allocated pens until removed by yardmen and taken to the sale ring.
20. All stock offered for sale must be catalogued and will be sold in that order. Registered and Herd Bulls can be mixed within the catalogue. Substitute lots cannot be offered in the event of withdrawals after the close of nominations, except in the following circumstances:- Substitute animals will be accepted from vendors who have nominated 2 head or less if the details of the substitute animal are notified in writing to the Society before close of business 6th August.
21. The Sale will be conducted on the basis of a single vendor draw within each agent's catalogue, except where a vendor's total nominations exceed the limit of 20 bulls in one run. In which case the vendor will have multiple draws within an agent's catalogue as required for each subsequent run of 20 bulls or part thereof.
22. If more than ten bulls and less than 20 are nominated with one agent, they may be split once to the proportion of vendors' choice or left in one draft.
23. Animals cannot be nominated for more than one sale at the same time.
24. All vendors (calculated on a pro rata basis for all lots sold) shall pay the following freight rebate. These prices are exclusive of GST.
 - (a) Buyers of packages of 5 bulls will be eligible for the following incentive rebates:
 - (1) WA, SA & Vic buyers \$200 / Bull.
 - (2) NT & NSW buyers \$100 / Bull.
 - (3) Qld buyers \$50 / Bull.
25. An Outside Agent Rebate of 4% will be paid to approved outside agents. The rebate will be charged to vendors on a pro rata basis on all lots sold. Approved Outside Agents:
 - a) Must nominate in writing to the Society, proposed buyers 48 hrs prior to commencement of the Sale.
 - b) May not nominate society members.
 - c) Payment for purchases must be received within 7 days of Sale.
 - d) Branches & franchises of Selling Agents are excluded.
 - e) Within two working days of completion of the sale, the **Outside Agent must notify the Droughtmaster office** listing lot numbers and price paid for each nominated buyer to be eligible for the rebate.
26. Insurance is the responsibility of the vendor and purchaser.
27. On arrival, vendors should check at the saleyard office for a list of available pens and the order of penning for the Sale.
28. It is strongly recommended that stock be vaccinated against EPHEMERAL FEVER (3 DAY SICKNESS) and BOTULISM. **NOTE: Correct vaccination program for 3 Day Sickness requires 2 vaccinations**
29. Participating agents are Landmark, Elders and Grant Daniel and Long, selling by preferred agent method.

30. Roma Saleyards is a **tick free** area.
31. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times whilst in the saleyards area and are NOT permitted in the sale ring or any working area. The DSBS and Saleyard Board will not be responsible for any injury inflicted through non-compliance with this order.
32. All information pertaining to Breedplan figures must be submitted prior to nomination and if an interim run has been done after the catalogue has been printed then the information must be available at the sale. All Breedplan members must comply with the Droughtmaster Breedplan Code of Practice.
33. A Droughtmaster animal shall not be eligible for sale if:
 - (a) In the case of an animal under 19 months (*580 days) of age on the day of examination by veterinarian, it has or has evidence of having had, a permanent tooth or teeth.
 - (b) In the case of an animal under 25 months (*763 days) of age on the day of examination by veterinarian, it has or has evidence of having had, more than two permanent teeth.
 - (c) In the case of an animal under 30 months (*915 days) of age on the day of examination by veterinarian, it has or has evidence of having had, more than four permanent teeth.The veterinarian conducting the ACV Soundness Evaluation must check and record the dentition of each animal. Animals must be withdrawn from sale if they do not meet these dentition standards.

Any vendor requiring assistance with selecting their draft should note this on the nomination form and they will be contacted by the Society to make arrangements. Any advice given will be “Non Binding”.

The “Pair of Bulls” will be judged early Friday morning, and will be judged “as they are penned” at the time of judging. If there are more than 2 bulls in a pen the judge shall select the 2 best bulls from that pen when making their judging decisions.

- The original ACV Bull Soundness Evaluation **Summary Certificate** must be brought to the sale and be available for inspection if requested by a Sale Committee Representative(s).
- ACV **Individual** Certificates must still be completed by the vet for each bull and a copy retained by both the vet and the vendor.
