Final Update/Reminders for 2010

1. Tick Pre treatments should be in line with either of the following, depending on which option you chose.

Option 1 when a **plunge dip or spray** was used: -

2nd treatment by dip or spray - between the 30th August & 2nd September.

3rd treatment by dip or spray - between the 8th & 10th September.

Option 2 when only **pour on or injectable** treatments (Macrocylic Lactones) were used: -

2nd treatment - between 6th & 8th September.

2. Documentation Lodgement / Dates

By 9th September ACV certificates, On property scanning & weight results, to the Society Office.

(Animals will be excluded from selling through the auction ring if the above documentation /treatment criteria has not been satisfied by the designated time. Bulls must also be clearly paint branded & tagged with the corresponding Droughtmaster Eartag.)

3. Feed & Bedding Hay purchases from CQLX

CQLX advises the following arrangements for ordering the above

- Feed can only be purchased from the hayshed and between 5.30am & 7am and 4.30pm & 6.30pm
- Bedding hay is to be **ordered from CQLX office prior to 4pm** for delivery to pens that afternoon. This hay may be in large square bales in which case a quarter of a bale/pen is suggested. Only CXLX supplied bedding may be used.
